LEVEL OF TEACHING

The school has separate wing for imparting education from I to VIII level, It provides a learning environment that encourages children to bring out the best courage's and enables their all- round development values and the celebration of cultural diversity.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

1. The school follows the CBSE curriculum.
2. The medium of teaching is English as it is the language of computers, conversation, business and most importantly, the language the world speaks,
3. At appropriate stage courses in general science social studies, mathematics and Sanskrit are included.
4. However equal emphasis is given to all languages such as Hindi, English, Sanskrit etc, through the target language increases the amount of exposure in the farness as one at the main subject in all classes.

SCHOOL TERMS

- * The school session is from April to March. The academic year is divided into semester. Weekly test is also conducted for the betterment of the students.

ATTENDANCE

1. 90% attendance is essential for promotion to the next class.
2. No leave is granted except of prior application from parents/guardian for genuine reasons.
3. In case of sickness, he/ she will have to produce a valid medical certificate.

WITHDRAWALS

1. Withdrawal from any class must be preceded by a month's notice or a month's fee if it is not given before one month.
2. All dues must be paid before a transfer certificate is issued.
3. S.L.C will be issued after one week from the date of receipt of the application
4. School authority may ask without prior notice to the parents to withdraw their wards form the school on the following grounds.
 - i. If the behavior of the student is harmful to the interest of the school .
 - ii. If the student uses abusive language in the classroom.
 - iii. If a student fails consecutively two years in the same class.
 - iv. If the students remain absent for 3 months without any prior information to the institution.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

Contact between parents and teachers are essential to complete the harmonious development of the student's personality. For this our school arranges parents meeting at every exam results. There are following points for observation:

1. Please check the school diary and remark column daily.
2. Please see that your ward has all the text books, items of stationary and craft materials.
3. Please ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform.
4. Please don't send the fee through the ward or another person.
5. Please don't send money, valuable thing and mobile with the student, the school will not take any responsibility if they are lost.
6. Please send the test copies/ papers as and when sent to you.
7. Please meet the teacher with prior permission from the principal.
8. Please don't go into the classroom to discuss any problem with the teacher as it disturbs the academic atmosphere of the class.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

A student and his parent will have to agree with the following rules and regulations of the school before taking admission:

1. A student must be regular and punctual.
2. There will be no provision of re examination in case of being absent from school during the examination.
3. If the student obtains more than 40% marks, he/she will be promoted in the next class.
4. Parents may discuss to the principal for promotion by giving application if their ward gets less than 40% marks.
5. A student must bring diary daily duly signed by guardian.
6. A student must attend in the morning assembly.
7. Students will not be allowed to leave the premises unless it is for a very genuine urgent reason.
8. Student is not allowed to damage the school property.
9. The school reserves the right to dismiss a student whose progress in study is steadily unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.
10. If any complain is to be made concerning a teacher, please meet the principal.
11. No student will attend the morning assembly if he is not well dressed in proper uniform.
